Kay Gieser Scholarship

The applicant must be the student of a missionary or full-time Christian worker. (Amount determined by need.)

Dwight T. Peterson International Scholarship

The student, student's father or student's mother shall carry a passport or hold citizenship in a country other than the United States. (\$400 for one student)

□ **Jean Clausen Ludwig Scholarship**

The applicant must demonstrate a financial need by completing a financial aid application, maintain a high academic standard and be recommended by a member of the faculty or staff of Wheaton Academy. (\$1,000 for two students)

- Submit a recommendation by a member of the faculty or staff of Wheaton Academy.
- Due to Financial Assistance Office by March 15th.
- Transcripts will be obtained from Student Services.

□ **The John and Vera McNally Award**

Application for this Award is based on Academic Excellence, Extracurricular School Activities, Community Activities, Science Interest, Manners and Athletics. □ **Gail Wittekind Endowment**

The recipient must be a member of a single-parent family, maintain a “B” grade point average, demonstrate strong moral character and leadership as evidenced by participation in an extra-curricular activity and demonstrate good manners in both dress and speech. The recipient must also be able to verbalize his or her Christian testimony and how God is working in his or her life. (\$1000 for one student)

- The applicant shall describe how he or she meets the above criteria in no more than 250 words.
- The response should be typed and double-spaced.
- Due to Financial Assistance Office by March 15th.

□ **David J. Engeseth Senior Leadership Award**

The recipient shall be a member of the senior class and exhibit applied leadership at Wheaton Academy, evidenced by a recommendation from a member of the faculty. Leadership may be exhibited in academics, sports, and/or sportsmanship. The recipient also must plan to attend a Christian college with award preference given toward attendance at Taylor University, Trinity International University, or Wheaton College. Other Christian colleges will be considered. The one exception to the college attendance requirement will be enlistment into the United States Armed Forces. The recipient of this award is chosen by the school and the award is presented at the Evening of Honor in the spring. (\$1,000 for one senior student)

- Leadership Award presented in the spring.

□ **The Todd Beamer Christian Character and Leadership Award**

During Todd Beamer’s high school days no one knew that he would be the national hero of Flight 93 in the first battle of the war on terror. What was known about Todd

was his continuous development and demonstration of leadership skills and a Christian testimony that were evident throughout his life.

The scholarship will be given to student(s) with financial need that demonstrate(s) excellence in Christian character and leadership potential as modeled by Todd Beamer while he was a student at Wheaton Academy.
